### Course Overview

### Course Fees

The all-inclusive course fee amounts to 980 € for undergraduate and postgraduate students. The all inclusive fee of 980 € consists of a tuition-charge (480 €) and a accommodation- and board-charge (500 €), which includes in addition a Regional Culture Programme and organised evening events following the courses, a Farewell-Evening and saturday weekend excursion. For students from partner universities tuition fees will be waived, and only fees for board and accommodation apply.
